

Completion of all of the requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the **California State University** or **University of California** system without the need, after transfer to take additional lower-division, general education courses to satisfy campus general education requirements.

The course requirements for all areas should be completed before the IGETC can be certified. Each course must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

Area 1 – English Composition

CSU – 3 courses required, one from each Area A, B, and C below.

UC – 2 courses required one from Area A and one from Area B.

Area A English Composition, 1 course, 3 semester units

English Writing 300 – *Required for transfer*

Area B Critical Thinking – English Composition, 1 course, 3 units

Communications Studies 311, 315; English Writing 302; Philosophy 328 – *Required for transfer*

Area C Oral Communication (CSU only), 1 course, 3 semester units

Communication Studies 301, 331*, 361* – *Required for transfer*

Area 2 – Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning

1 course, 3 semester units – *required for transfer*

Area 3 – Art and Humanities

At least 3 courses with at least one from the Arts and one from the Humanities. 9 semester units

OR Completion of two years of the same foreign language in high school with "C" or better.
