

GENERAL EDUCATION AT UC DAVIS

General Education is a graduation requirement for all UC Davis students; certification of IGETC fulfills this GE Requirement.

Transfer courses comparable to approved UCD courses that meet General Education can transfer to meet GE. Lists of UC Davis courses which meet the following GE areas, A, B, & C, are published in the UC Davis General Catalog, the Class Schedule and Room Directory, and are articulated with your community college courses on the Web based ASSIST at www.assist.org. The Los Rios articulated courses to this GE pattern are listed on the back of this page.

If you choose to satisfy the UC Davis GE requirement instead of IGETC, it is possible to complete part or all of UC Davis GE with community college coursework. Courses must be completed with a letter grade in order to satisfy GE.

The UC Davis GE requirement has three components:

1. Topical Breadth (TB) – Six (6) GE courses consisting of three (3) courses in each of the two subject areas other than your major's assigned area.
2. Writing experience (W) – Three (3) GE courses (taken after completion of ENGWR 300 or AP English Exam with score of 3 or above).
3. Social-Cultural Diversity (D) – One (1) GE course.

Some courses count toward two or three components of GE. For example, a single course might provide GE credit for topical breadth, writing experience, and social-cultural diversity. The following codes will be used with the courses listed on the reverse side to indicate GE components for each course.

TB-AH:	Topical Breadth – Arts and Humanities
TB-SE:	Topical Breadth – Science and Engineering
TB-SS:	Topical Breadth – Social Science
W:	Writing Experience
D:	Social Cultural Diversity
