

CRC GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS 2010-2011

MINIMUM GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A. Satisfactory completion of 60 units of collegiate work with a "C" (2.0) grade point average in a curriculum that the district accepts toward the degree. At least 12 units must be earned at Cosumnes River College. Effective summer 2004, students who possess a BA/BS degree or higher will have satisfied general education and competency requirements for the AA/AS degree. Students with degrees earned outside the US will be evaluated on an individual basis.

B. MAJOR

One of the degree programs listed in this catalog with a minimum "C" grade in each course for the major.

Students receiving an exemption for any reason must complete a minimum of 3 units under 6(b).* **AND**

E. GRADUATION COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS

Demonstrate college-level competence in reading, written expression and mathematics.

(NOTE: These requirements are effective ONLY for students who either first begin taking classes at CRC, or who re-establish Catalog Rights in the fall semester of 2009.)

1) Reading Competency

Competency is demonstrated by either:

a) Completion with a grade of "C" or better in **ENGRD** 310 or 312 or an equivalent college reading course at an accredited college. Students who possess an A.A. /A.S. degree or higher shall be deemed competent in reading. **OR**

b) Obtaining a satisfactory score on a reading examination.

2) Written Expression Competency

Competency is demonstrated by:

Completion with a grade of "C" or better in **ENGWR** 300 or **BUS** 310 or an equivalent course at an accredited college.

3) Mathematics Competency

Competency is demonstrated by either:

a) Completion with a grade of "C" or better of **MATH** 110, 120, 125, or designated higher level mathematics course (incl. **STAT** 300); **PSYC** 330, or a college-level math course at an accredited college. **OR**

b) Obtaining a satisfactory score on a mathematics examination.

Please note: The Cosumnes River College Catalog denotes GE categories using an alphanumeric method with Roman numerals (e.g., "I. a"), while the CRC Graduation Requirements course list uses an alphanumeric method with Arabic numerals (e.g., "5. a"). In an effort to ease confusion, the following chart may be used.

Natural Sciences- 1 = IV

Social and Behavioral Sciences- 2 = V (b)

American Institutions- 3 = V (a)

Humanities- 4 = I

Languages & Rationality/English Composition- 5 a = II (a)

Languages & Rationality/Communications & Analytical Thinking-5 b = II (b)

Living Skills/Physical Education- 6 a = III (a)

Living Skills/Other- 6 b and c = III (b)

Ethnic/Multicultural Studies Requirement- 7 = VI
