Information and materials all students will need to bring to complete their FAFSA:

- student's Social Security card and drivers license (or government-issued ID)
- parent's or guardian's Social Security card
- parent's federal income tax return or W-2 forms from tax year 2007
- records of untaxed income such as TANF, veterans benefits, Social Security benefits
- student's W-2 forms, pay records or records of income earned during 2007
- bank account records or statements
- records of stocks, bonds or investments
- business records
- if not a US citizen, bring alien registration card
- a list of the colleges you are interested in

Remember, to qualify for a Cal Grant you must submit the FAFSA and GPA verification form no later than March 2, 2008.
