1. Be a woman 25 years of age or older by September 1, 2011.
2. Be a resident of Sacramento County and be enrolled at one of the following colleges:
 - a. American River College
 - b. Cosumnes River College
 - c. Folsom Lake College
 - d. Sacramento City College
 - e. California State University, Sacramento
3. Be scheduled to take at least six (6) units in September, 2011 at one of the five above-mentioned colleges, and to graduate no earlier than May, 2012.
4. Have completed at least twelve (12) units of credit from an accredited college or university with a Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher.
5. Be in pursuit of her first baccalaureate degree.
6. Have clearly defined educational and career goals.
7. Demonstrate evidence of financial need.
8. Be able and willing to attend one (1) AAUW Sacramento Branch meeting during the 2011-2012 academic year to speak briefly about her course of study and career goals.

Educational Background: Include high school, college (past and present), units completed, workshops, seminars, academic achievements, awards, and honors. Attach a separate sheet. Your resume with this information is acceptable.

Work Experience: On a separate sheet, please list your past employers and describe your responsibilities. Your resume with this information is acceptable.

Essay: Attach a typed 1-2 page double-spaced essay on your personal goals and achievements and your career objective. Explain why a scholarship is needed. Include pertinent biographical information.

Unofficial Transcripts: Transcript of twelve (12) or more units from an accredited college or university that discloses all the courses enrolled in, grade, semester Grade Point Average (GPA) with Quality Points indicated, and the cumulative GPA with Quality Points indicated.

Official Transcripts: Official transcripts of twelve (12) or more completed units from one or more accredited colleges or universities will be required of the chosen recipient before the award is given. These transcripts must be submitted in an unopened, sealed envelope
