DO YOU NEED TO TAKE THE ATB (Financial Aid “Ability to Benefit”) TEST????

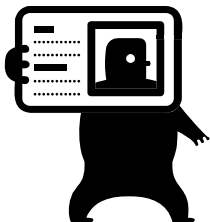
The ATB Test is required for students who do not have a High School Diploma, GED, or CHSPE in order to apply for the FAFSA.

The Assessment Center offers three options for those who need to take the ATB test:

- **Computer:**
 - **Come in during Assessment Center walk-in hours (see Assessment Center schedule), first-come, first-served. No appointment is required to take the computerized ATB test. The test is not timed. *This test may be repeated after 24 hours, but only with a Counselor referral.***
- **Paper/Pencil:**
 - **Students may come in the last Friday of the month and take a CPAt ATB test (see Assessment Center schedule). It is a paper/pencil test and is timed. No appointment is required. *This test may be repeated after 30 days with a Counselor referral.***
- **Students in ESL courses:**
 - **Students enrolled in ESL (English-as-a-Second Language) classes: must take the ESL version of the ATB test. They may come in during walk-in testing hours to take the ESL ATB test (see Assessment Center schedule). *This test is timed. There are 2 versions of this test. Each one may be re-taken after a 15 day waiting period with a Counselor referral.***

What happens after you take the ATB test?

- **RESULTS: The Assessment Center Staff will tell you when you can come back to get your results. Whenever possible, you will have the results the same day you take the test.**
- **IF YOU PASS the ATB test, have the Financial Aid Office call us to verify.**
- **IF YOU DO NOT PASS, you may repeat the ATB test based on the repeat policies listed above.**
