

# PUBLIC TRANSIT ACCESS



Students can access the Davis Center by using public transit. Depending on where the student travels from, this may require use of multiple transit systems, which are free of charge to students with a valid semester sticker on their Student Access Card (note: only the V-line is free on Unitrans).

Below are sample routes between the Davis Center and the main campus of Sacramento City College (average travel time is about 2 hours each way).

## Sacramento City College to Davis Center

- Start at City College Light Rail Station
- Take SacRT Light Rail Blue (towards Watt/I-80 Station) to St.Rose Lima Park station
- Walk to L & 9th St
- Take Yolo Bus 42A Intercity Clockwise to Memorial Union (at UCD)
- Walk to Silo Terminal
- Take Unitrans V-line to West Village Square & Town Square
- Arrive at Davis Center

## Davis Center to Sacramento City College

- Start at Unitrans bus stop: West Village Square & Community College
- Take Unitrans V-line to Silo Terminal
- Walk to Memorial Union
- Take Yolo Bus 42B to 5th & L Street station (downtown Sacramento)
- Walk to 7th & Capitol Avenue station
- Take SacRT Light Rail Blue (towards Meadowview station) to City College Station
- Arrive at Sacramento City College
