Academic & Progress Probation

In 2015, the Student Success team started an early intervention/retention initiative targeting at-risk students who were unable to successfully progress through the semester.

Probation students are defined as students who did not earn a GPA of 2.0 or higher or withdrew from 50% of their overall classes.

Academic Probation 1 students are required to:

- Attend a Fresh Start Workshop
- Meet one-on-one with a Success Coach

Since implementing this process:

3413 students have seen a success coach

2890 students have attended a Fresh Start Workshop

67% Experienced an increase in GPA or progress completion rate after success coaching

Summer Bridge Program



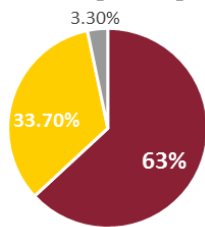
City 101

Sacramento City College's *City 101* summer bridge program prepares incoming freshmen in making a smooth transition from high school into college. *City 101* is designed to familiarize and acquaint students with college expectations, peer networking, and campus resources. The program emphasizes collaboration and community building and provides them with meaningful opportunities to engage with peers, faculty, and staff. *City 101* is provided free of cost to students.

- 89% Remained in Good Academic Standing

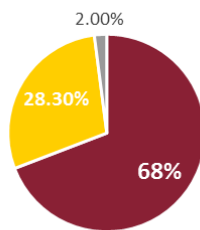

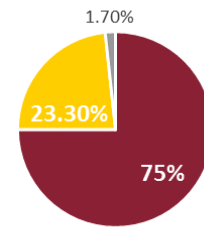
