In the past it was essentially “fixing” concerns; however, it was suggested to “broaden” the undertakings.
I. HSI- STEM Grant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The President shared that via Congress member Doris Matsui’s office SCC has been approved for the HSI-STEM Grant for \$3.85M. This grant will help expand services for Hispanic and low income students.
J. President’s Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will be sending 3 people from each constituency group to the Education Advisory Board (EAB) for October 20, in Santa Monica. This Student Success Collaborative “navigate” is to address “Onboarding Students into Guided Pathways. • The IEPI, in partnership with the Academic Senate and AACC CA Guided Pathways College is sponsoring a two-day event December 7, 8. We will need to send a team. • There is a “Teaching Fellows Exploratory Meeting, Sept 23 noon – 1 at CSUS, which is essentially to learn about Fresno’s Teaching Fellows Program and to explore the possibility of launching a similar program in our region.
