



# SENIOR YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE CALENDAR & CHECKLIST

## AUGUST/SEPTEMBER

- Review your career plans and decide which school is right for you.
- Visit the college campuses you're interested in.
- Request information about specific academic programs and/or courses.

## OCTOBER/NOVEMBER

- Apply online beginning November 1: [success.losrios.edu](http://success.losrios.edu)
- SUBMIT YOUR FAFSA** Priority October 1–March 2. Submit the FAFSA online—[www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
- SUBMIT YOUR CALIFORNIA DREAM ACT** Priority October 1 – March 2. Submit the CA Dream Act online — <https://dream.csac.ca.gov>
- Attend special programs such as local college fairs and information nights at your high school.
- Talk with the outreach representative who visits your high school to ask questions about specific certificates, degrees, and transferring.
- Check in with your Career Center regularly and utilize other resources to search for scholarship opportunities.

**Helpful Hint:** Make or print copies of anything you submit to have for your records.

## JANUARY/FEBRUARY

- Complete Online Orientation
- Set-up your Student Gmail account: [apps.losrios.edu](http://apps.losrios.edu)
- Meet with the outreach representative who visits your high school to learn more about available financial and academic support services.

## MARCH/APRIL

- Choose your classes & enter them into the “shopping cart.” Follow the instructions. When your enrollment date arrives, you only need to click “finish enrolling.”

## APRIL

- Check your e-services account for your enrollment date.
- Monitor your “To-Do” list on e-Services for additional documents required for Financial Aid.

## MAY

- Be sure to register for Summer and/or Fall classes on your enrollment date!
