The Student Associated Council is the associated student organization of Sacramento City College. It is made of two boards:

Clubs and Events Board

The Clubs and Events Board is a team of student leaders promoting and facilitating student involvement in both campus and club activities.

Student Senate

The Student Senate is a team of student leaders that represent the interests of the students of Sacramento City College to campus and district administrators as well as state and federal legislators.

The Student Associated Council is a great leadership opportunity for students to meet new people and have fun, while working to serve your fellow students. Student Leaders gain invaluable experience that reflects highly for transfer, scholarships, or job applications; those eligible will also receive a leadership notation on their transcript.

Can anyone join?

Process of Appointment to the Student Associated Council

Student Senate

1. To complete the Candidate Public Information form and the Candidacy Verification form, please visit www.scc.losrios.edu/sld and look under the SAC forms menu bar on the left hand side of page. The Advisor uses this information to verify candidate eligibility. Once appointed, contact information will be included on the SAC roster. Any information provided on the Public Information form may be shared with the public.
2. Meet with Advisor Kim Beyrer for an orientation.
3. Meeting requirements:
 - a) Attend one (1) Monday meeting of the Senators.
 - b) Attend three (3) Wednesday meetings.
 - c) At the Wednesday meetings, sit at the table with the current board and utilize a "Candidate" nameplate that will be provided.
 - d) You may be asked to speak about yourself and why you wish to join the Student Senate, your familiarity with the Student Associated Council Constitution and the Student Senate Bylaws, and your understanding of the position you are seeking.
 - e) At the third Wednesday meeting, you may be appointed to the board by a vote of the Student Senate.
 - f) Get involved and seek out mentorship from a current board member.

Note that any activity you are engaged in with the board will be considered unofficial until you have been officially appointed.
